Mr. Richardson,

I left you a voice message but wanted to follow up. I would like Senator Warner's help getting the Department of the Interior to get the amended CFR 36, Regulation 2.4 from the VCDL petition for rule making published in the next federal register for comment and subsequent implementation. DOI has had this petition for rule making under review "in the Solicitor's Office" for almost 10 months now. Repeated contacts with the Department of the Interior and National Park Service have resulted in the same "Karen Taylor-Goodrich" letter being issued since February '05. There is no justification for further delay.

We really need Senator Warner's help to get the Department of the Interior to stop stonewalling VCDL's petition and publish the amended regulation 2.4.
